Description

Explore some aspect relating to the themes in this course that interest you and really delve into it to share with the class. You will create a report with supporting images or video and post it on our course website. Some possibilities might include researching a particular artist that relates to your work, or looking at something that links several artists together, a technique that interests you, a print or book that you may have seen at Special Collections or in a presentation in class, a printshop, collective, etc. You may decide to do research relating to your next project, or contact an artist to interview them.

I will email each of you with an invitation to become an editor to our class Weebly site. After you accept, you can post your research on the blog section of the site and write comments on other people's posts. You will need to title your research project, and include your name at the top of the posting.

After you've posted, each of you will need to respond to at least 3 different classmate's research. The Intro to Print class will also be using the site to post their research. You may respond to their research as well if you wish.

Project Guidelines

1. A title of your project and your name MUST be at the top of the report
2. You MUST include citations. No style specified
3. Minimum word length: 500
4. Minimum images or video: 2
5. Minimum responses to other student's projects: 3
